

Our programs involve a high amount of experiential learning (learning by doing). Instead of talking about canoeing in a classroom, we will be out on the lake doing it! Other skills that students will learn include fire-building, shelter-making, icefishing, land navigation, archery, crosscountry skiing, snowshoeing, wilderness first-aid, team-building, firearm safety and other survival skills.

Students will also get to engage with traditional knowledge keepers to guide them through their journey of connecting with the land. We are very excited for the activities and field trips we will get to do this year, including our outdoors/canoe club at the school!

Kapawe'no First Nation - The newest school serving grade 4 to 12 students in High Prairie and the surrounding communities has arrived. The First Nation Distance Learning Centre is open to all students entering Grade 4 to Grade 12 and features an Alberta Accredited Program of studies for in person and virtual (distance education) learning.

The First Nation Distance Learning Centre operates with over 20 certificated Alberta Teachers and twenty support staff instructing a full compliment of courses at each grade level. (152 Academic High School Courses at the -1 and -2 Level of every high school grade are being offered this upcoming school year to students including courses in Indigenous Music, Fine Arts, Sports and Recreation).

This year both boys and girls sports teams will compete in the Alberta High School





Athletic Association's competitive sports and the school will run an elite under 15 travel Hockey Team featuring some of the best boys and girls under 15 Hockey Players in the area. All athletes on this team will be supported fully for travel and competitive play.

The Fine Arts/Music program at the school has been enhanced with a full Big Band Music Program being added to the current contemporary music program which was recognized last year for its inclusion of traditional drumming and singing. The Kapawe'no Holistic Knowledge Academy (KHKA) is collecting personal information about your child with this registration form. The information supports a Lifelong Learning Educational Program for your child and ensures a safe environment for all students and staff. Some of the ways the school may use the collected information are listed below. The Information and Privacy Commissioner's Office states that the school does NOT need written consent from you to:

- Share information with Alberta Education.
- Use a student's name, contact information, and phone number in their absence.
- Use a student's name, photo, or video in the newsletter, yearbook, or within the school community.
- Use a student's name on artwork or material displayed at the school.
- Use the student's name and academic information when the school wishes to apply for provincial or federal awards on behalf of the student.
- Provide student information including photos for identification purposes. Student phone numbers will be provided to bus drivers.

This is not a complete list; it merely gives some examples of how the personal information may be used.

Some of the activities we do at our academy besides providing a solid academic program are sporting competitions, concerts, cultural programs, clubs, field trips, graduation, and water or land-based teachings that require students to be on the water or harvesting plants and animals in the wild. 
